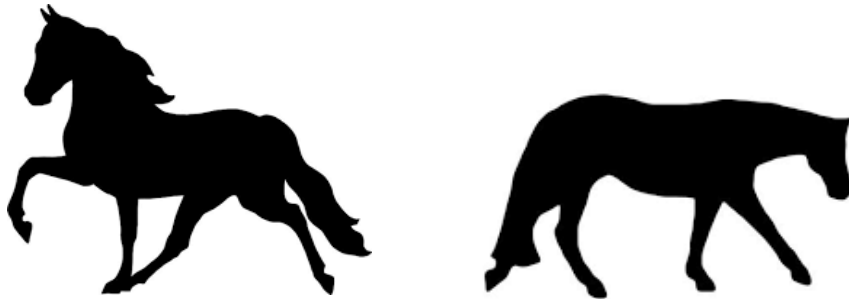

 **Catalog Race**-The contestant must race to a barrel placed at the far end of the arena. On the barrel, a catalog is placed which the contestant must either ride to dismount and tear out a given page number or tear the page while on the horse. Then, ride back to the starting line. The fastest time is the winner.

 **Ball and Pail Race**- Pattern same as catalog, using tennis ball proceed around barrel and drop ball into pail. Proceed back to the starting line. Fastest time is the winner. No time for dropping the ball, missing the pail, knocking down the barrel, or dismounting the horse.

 **Panty Hose Race**- Teams of two riders each holding end of a pair of panty hose race to end of arena, around barrel, and return across the line without dropping or breaking contact between the two riders and the panty hose. Both riders must be connected to the panty hose and the panty hose remaining in one piece at time of crossing timer line. No time for dropping, disconnecting each other by tearing panty hose, or knocking down the barrel.
