The 2025 Spring Fun Show will follow the rules and regulations of SHOW, Inc. and the Tennessee Walking Horse National Celebration<sup>®</sup>

- SHOW, Inc. requires all entry sheets to contain the following information before a DQP will inspect an entry: 1. Horse's official name and registration number 2. Trainer's name, complete address and license number 3. Exhibitor's name and complete address 4. Owner's name and complete address. <u>All padded entries will be subject to a \$30 per entry inspection fee.</u> All Flat Shod entries will be subject to a one-time per show inspection fee of \$30 per entry and an additional \$5.00 per entry inspection fee.
- ALL HORSES OVER SIX MONTHS OF AGE MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST WITHIN THE LAST 12 MONTHS TO BE ON THE CELEBRATION GROUNDS. COGGINS TEST CERTIFICATES SHOULD ACCOMPANY THE VEHICLE TRANSPORTING HORSES. Anyone found in violation will be cited, fined, and instructed to remove the horse from the Celebration grounds by the Tennessee Department of Agriculture personnel. The minimum fine in Bedford County is \$150.00. In addition, ALL OUT-OF-STATE HORSES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE OR EQUINE INTERSTATE EVENT PERMIT (EQUINE PASSPORT) OBTAINED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE EVENT AS STATED BY THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.
- Under Tennessee State Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
- There will be NO REFUNDS on entries and stalls.
- All Riders Cup Classes are Triple Points.

PERSONS ON FEDERAL DISQUALIFICATION CANNOT TRANSPORT HORSES TO THIS SHOW AND CAN PARTICIPATE ONLY AS A SPECTATOR.

Premiums, less any amounts owed The Celebration® will be paid by check drawn to the order of the name listed on the Prize Disbursement Form.

## SHOW FEES

GROUNDS FEE - \$35 per horse, INCLUDES ONE STALL

**EXHIBITOR PARKING PASS -** \$35 per show, \$30 Friday-Saturday, \$20 per night, includes tax (*all vehicles except trucks pulling trailers will require an Exhibitors Pass to enter Gate A*. Passes can be purchased at Gate A.

**GOLF CART PASS -** \$20.00, includes tax (Proof of liability insurance required)

RV PARK SPACE - \$50.00 per night, includes tax
